RULES FOR THE SHOW.

The Show will be held under Kennel Club Rules and Show Regulations in force at date of publication of Schedule.

2. All dogs must be registered. Where a change of ownership of a registered dog has taken place, the transfer must be made at the Kennel Club previous to the Show.

3. One dog can be entered in several classes if eligible, but full

entrance fee must be paid for each class.

4. A dog entered in a wrong class will be excluded from competition and the entrance fee forfeited. The entrance fee of a dog entered but not exhibited, will also be forfeited.

5. Judging. This will commence at 12.30 p.m. Exhibits will be

received from 10 a.m. No exhibits will be received after 12.30 p.m., except under very exceptional and unforeseen circumstances and by special permission of the Show Manager. Exhibitors arriving after 12.30 p.m. should note their responsibility as to judging.

6. Should any judge be prevented from fulfilling his engagement the Executive reserve the right to appoint another in his place, subject

to the terms of the Kennel Club Show Regulation 7(r.)

7. Passes will be sent to all exhibitors and will be a receipt for entry fees. Should the passes not arrive, exhibits should be brought to the Show. No fees will be returned on the grounds of non-receipt of passes, etc.

8. Closing of Show. The Show will close at 5.30 p.m.
9. Early Removals. No early removals will be granted according to Kennel Club Rules and Show Regulations.

10. Except where bona-fide mistakes, fraud, misrepresentation, or breach of the Rules is discovered the judge's decision is final.

11. Exhibitors making entries must abide by the Rules and Show Regulations of the Kennel Club. All entries are accepted without any

conditions in any shape or form.

12. Exhibitors wishing to sell their dogs may state on the entry form the price at which they are prepared to sell them. Sales must be effected through the Secretary's Office, and 10 per cent commission to non members will be charged. If more than one claim is made for any specific dog or dogs before 4 p.m. on day of Show the Honorary Secretary shall at her discretion either have such dog or dogs sold by auction or by tender. (Subject to Kennel Club Show Regulation 25.)

13. The Committee reserve the right, on reasonable grounds, to

refuse any entries.

14. The Emergency Executive will be empowered to exclude any dog which is not in a fit state for exhibition, either from disease, vice or any other cause whatsoever, and to cause removal should such symptoms exhibit themselves during the Show.

15. The Committee will not be responsible for the loss or damage

to a dog or dogs, or any other property, whether arising from accident or any other cause whatsoever, nor for any act or omission of themselves their officers, servants, or others, and it is on this understanding only that entries are accepted.

16. The Committee will not be in any way responsible for any claim for injury, or compensation occasioned by or arising out of the holding of the Show or by reason of the act or default of any person

17. An announcement prior to date of closing of entries in "Our Dogs" or the "Dog World," of any alteration made by the Committee, shall be deemed sufficent notice thereof.

18. All Rules and Regulations printed for convenience in other parts of this Schedule shall be deemed to be the Regulations of the Committee and shall have the same effect as if they formed part of Committee and shall have the same effect as if they formed part of these Regulations.

1. This Show is held under K.C. 3. Payment of Prize Money will be made in accordance with the provisions of Kennel Club Show Regulation 33 not later than 31 days from the close of a Show 4. Any objections to dogs must be made in accordance with the provisions of Kennel Club Show Regulation 27, and will be dealt with in strict conformity with that rule.

5. Disqualification and Forfeit of Prizes.—A dog is liable to be disqualified on objection from winning any award by the Committee or by the Show Committee subject to appeal to the Committee if proved to have been:—

(a) Exhibited at an unrecognized Show.

(b) Exhibited by a person disqualified or suspended under Rules 16, 17 or 16 as from the date of the charge having been lodged at the Kennel Club and for the period of the disqualification or suspension.

(c) Entered after the date fixed for closing entries or in a manner not complying with the Classification in the Schedule, or not in accordance with Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

(d) Totally blind or afflicted with a tendency to reproduce any hereding breeding.

(d) Totally blind or afflicted with a tendency to reproduce any hereditary disease defective in hearing, castrated, spayed, or otherwise prevented from breeding as the result of a surgical operation, suffering from an infectious or contagious disease, or prepared for exhibition in contravention of Regulations (e) Exhibited for competition, or handled in ring, by a Judge of dogs of the Show (f) Owned by the Judge within a period of twelve months, or if a puppy bred by him, except that this shall not apply to a substituted Judge, if the Judge of the breed be changed after the closing of entries.

(g) Boarded or given attention for payment within twelve months by the scheduled Judge of the breed at the Show.

(h) Not duly registered or transferred at the Kennel Club.

(j) The progeny resulting from the artificial fertilization of a bitch, unless prior permission was obtained from the Committee of the Kennel Club and such conditions were complied with as it considered advisable to preven the possibility of fraud.

(k) If a dog is entered in a class for which it is ineligible and is not withdrawn from competition before commencement of the judging of the class in question, the dog shall be disqualified. All such cases must be reported by the exhibitor to Show Secretary and by the latter to the Kennel Club, and the exhibitor may be fined at the discretion of the Committee.

9. No dog under six months of age can be exhibited except in a Litter Class.

10. No person may interfere in any way with the benching as erected accordance with Regulation 18 of the Kennel Club Show Regulations, and in particular the partitions as erected between one pen and another must not removed under any circumstances. Toy dogs must not be placed in front of the official space provided for them, nor must any private intimation or written or printed matter other than the official award cards be attached to or placed upon any bench or pen except notices of club meetings, sales or other notices of similar nature authorized by the Executive of the Show.
