SHOW REGULATIONS.

1. The Show will be held under Kennel Club Rules and Show Regulations in force at the date of the publication of this schedule, and every Exhibitor making an entry or entries at this Show shall be deemed to have agreed to abide by the Kennel Club Rules and Show Regulations, and it is on this understanding only that entries are received.

2. All entries must be made on or before Sat. July 14th (Postmark) on entry

Jorms issued for that purpose.

3. The entry fee will be 6/- per dog per class (Non Members) and 5/- per dog per class Members. Prize Money First 20/-, Second 10/-, Third 5/-.

4. A dog entered in a wrong class will be excluded from competition and the entrance fee forfeited. The entrance fee of a dog entered but not exhibited will also be forfeited.

5. The Committee reserve to themsleves the right to refuse any entries they

may think fit to exclude.

6. Exhibitors passes will be sent to Exhibitors and will be a receipt for entry fees. Should the passes not arrive, the exhibits should be brought to the Show. No fee can be returned on the grounds of non-receipt of passes.

7. Should any judge be prevented from fulfilling his/her engagement the Committee reserve the right to appoint another in his or her place, subject

to the terms of the Kennel Club Show Regulation 21 (1)

8. The Hon. Veterinary Surgeon, or Hon. Secretary will be empowered to exclude any dog which in his opinion is not in a fit state for exhibition, either from disease, vice or any other reason, and if such exclusion takes place either before or after the dog is judged, the entrance fee will be forfeited.

9. Judging and Arrival—Judging will commence at 11. 30 a.m. and Exhibitors

will be resonsible for their dogs being in time for the judging.

No dog will be received after 11. 30 p.m. except through very exceptional and unforeseen circumstances and by special permission of the Show Manager.

10. The Show will close at 5, 30 p.m.

11. An announcement prior to the date of closing of entries in "Our Dogs or "Dog World" of any alteration made to the schedule or in these regulations shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof.

12. The Committee will not be responsible for the loss or damage to a dog or dogs or any other property, whether arising from accident or any cause whatever, nor for any act of omission of themselves, their officers, servants or others, and it is on this understanding only that entries are accepted.

13. Exhibitors wishing to sell their dogs, may state on the entry form the price at which they wish to sell. Any sale must be effected through the Secretary's office, and 10% commission will be charged. If more than one claim is made for a specific dog, or dogs, the Secretary shall at his discretion either have such dog or dogs sold by auction or tender (subject to K.C. Show Regulation 30.) All applications for purchase must be made at Secretary's office before 4, 30 p.m.

14. In accordance with Kennel Club Regulation 26 (a) judging for Best in

Show must take place before 5. p.m.

15. Prize Money. Prize money will be paid strictly on the understanding that it will be returned to the Hon. Secretary should the dog be subsequently disqualified.

16. Exh ib tors must provide drinking bowls and food for their own dogs. 17. Should any question arise not provided for in these Regulations the decision of the Committee shall be final, subject only to appeal to the Kennel Club.

18. All classes will be for Dog or Bitch unless otherwise stated.

DEFINITION of CLASSES

All Classes Dog and Bitch unless otherwise stated.

In estimating the number of prizes won, all wins previous to the midnight preceding the day specified in the Schedule for closing entries shall be counted when entering any class. Equal awards shall count as a win for each dog so placed.

In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members classes or competing for Members Specials, each member of such partnership must at the time of entry, be a member of this Society. Puppies under six calendar months on day of Show are not eligible for exhibition at this Show.

Wins in Variety Classes do not count for entry in Breed Classes and a win

not dependent on judging by breed points does not count.

A Variety Class is one in which more than one Breed or Variety of a breed can compete. A First prize, does not include a First prize in Club stakes or a Special prize of whatever value. With this proviso the following are the definitions of certain classes:—

PUPPY For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

JUNIOR.. For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

NOVICE ... For dogs which have not won more than two First prizes each of the value of £1 or more.

NOTE—No dog is eligible for entry Maiden, Novice, Tyro, Debutant and Undergraduate classes which has won a Challenge Certificat or has obtained any award that counts towards the title of Champion under the Rules or any Governing Body recognised by the Kennel Club.

When entering for Graduate, Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit or Open Classes, exhibitors must count all First prize wins of £2 or more in class es

listed in definitions whether restricted or not.

POST GRADUATE For dogs which have not won more than four First prizes each of the value of £2 or more in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit or Open Classes.

LIMIT ... For dogs which have not won three Challenge Certificates under three different judges or more than six First prizes in all each of the value of £2 or more in Open and Limit classes confined to the breed at shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

OPEN For all dogs. If confined to a breed or variety for all dogs of that breed or variety.

SPECIAL BEGINNERS Exhibit and Exhibitor not to have won a First prize in the Breed,
